The LRCFT will host faculty forums over the next two weeks to answer questions regarding the proposed new salary schedules. Nov. 29 closes the election.

This semester the LRCFT will preside over internal elections for campus union president at the four colleges.

The LRCFT PAFC recently interviewed Dave Jones, Eric Guerra, Tecoy Porter, and Mathew Burgess for the SD 6 race.

The LRCFT PAFC will vote to endorse the MLK marches in January.

The LRCFT is sponsoring faculty to take part in the Run to Feed the Hungry in Sacramento

The LRCFT will continue to invite LRCCD trustees to our meetings over the next six months.

The LRCFT exec. board continues to conduct an Equity Audit of existing LRCFT board and union practices.

The LRCFT continues to maintain and augment a Faculty Relief Fund to assist faculty in need, particularly part time faculty.

Our next LRCFT executive board meeting is November 17, from 3-5 pm.
