LRCFT negotiators continue to work with LRCCD to finalize our new mandatory equity training component of our contract to be in place by the start of fall semester.

LRCFT continues to meet with state leadership and local legislators to improve PT faculty access to health care, job security, and pay parity.

The California Federation of Teachers and the LRCFT continue to lobby legislators against passage of AB 1705.

The LRCFT is gearing back up to assist our local candidates endorsed by the LRCFT for the November election.

The LRCFT is sponsoring three of our board members to attend the Los Rios trip to Ghana in September.

Eight LRCFT exec. board members will also attend our national American Federation of Teachers conference in Boston this week.

In closing, the LRCFT is proud to support the upcoming Naturalization and DACA workshop being conducted by the Coalition for Humane Immigrant Rights (CHIRLA). This in person event will be on Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup> at Sacramento City College starting at 9am. CHIRLA will provide free legal consultations, workshops on Naturalization for those students and faculty and classified staff who are permanent residents and wish to become US Citizens, as well as those who wish to renew their DACA forms. CHIRLA will help with the costs for both applications for qualifying individuals. We will offer more specifics shortly as to time and location on the SCC Campus.
