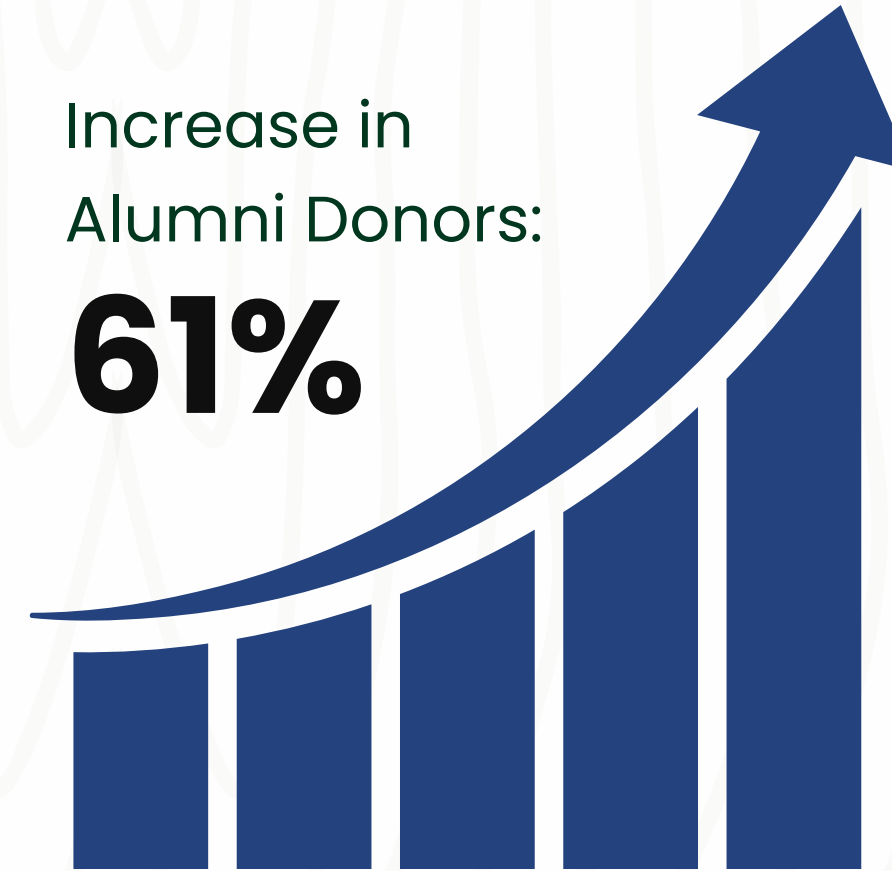

Grants

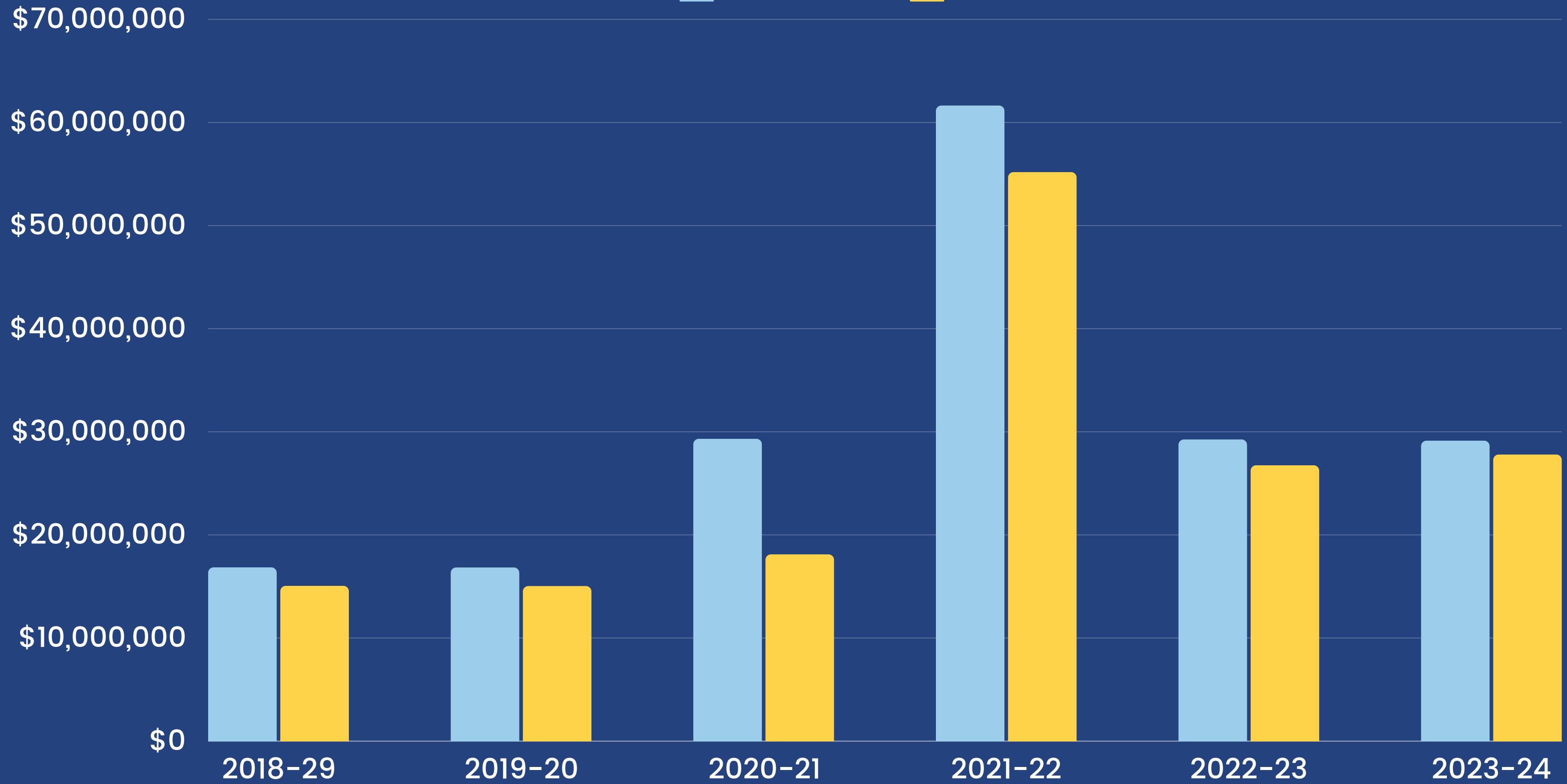
- Primary point of contact for grant-related matters

Grants by College FY24



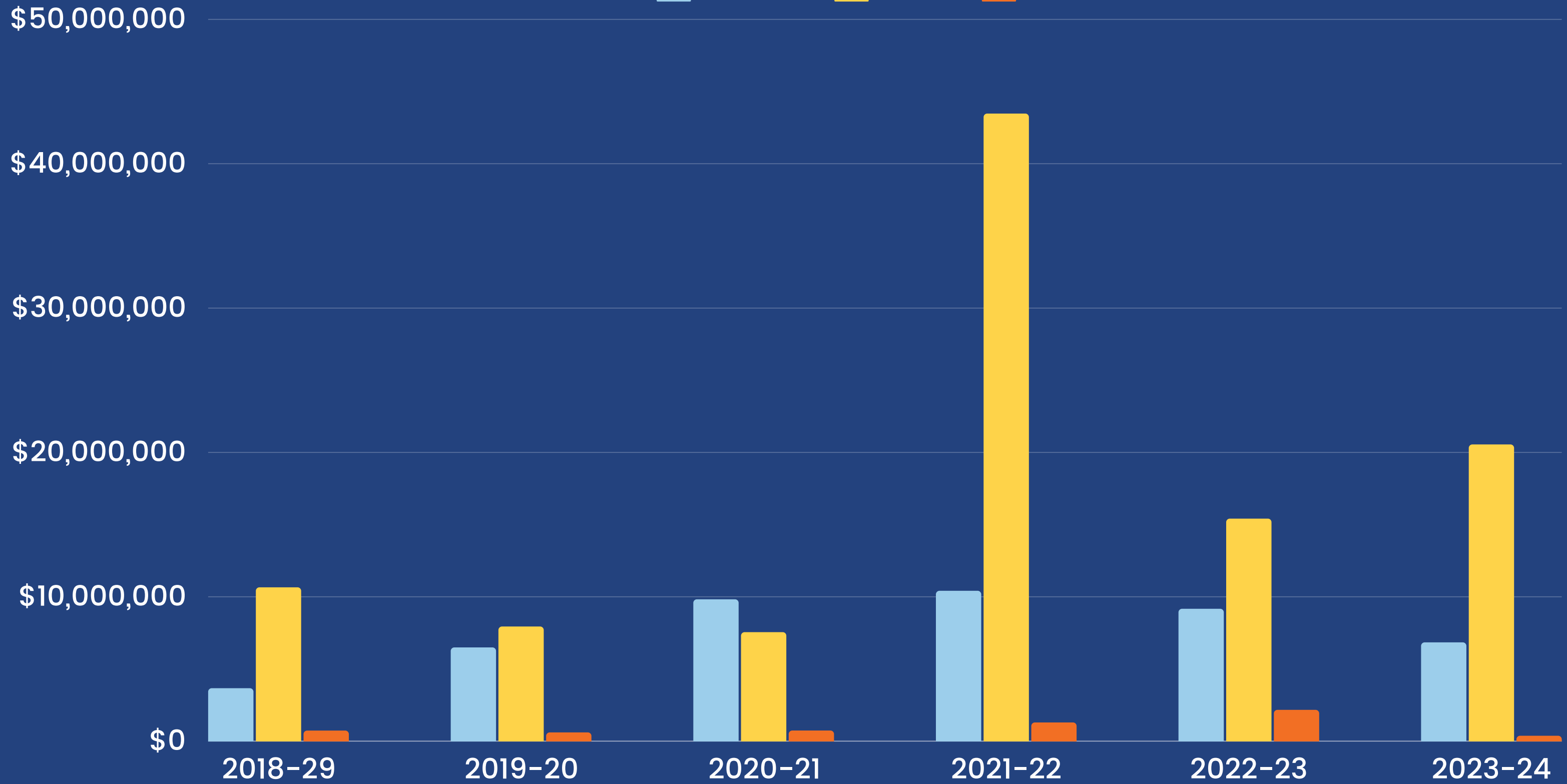

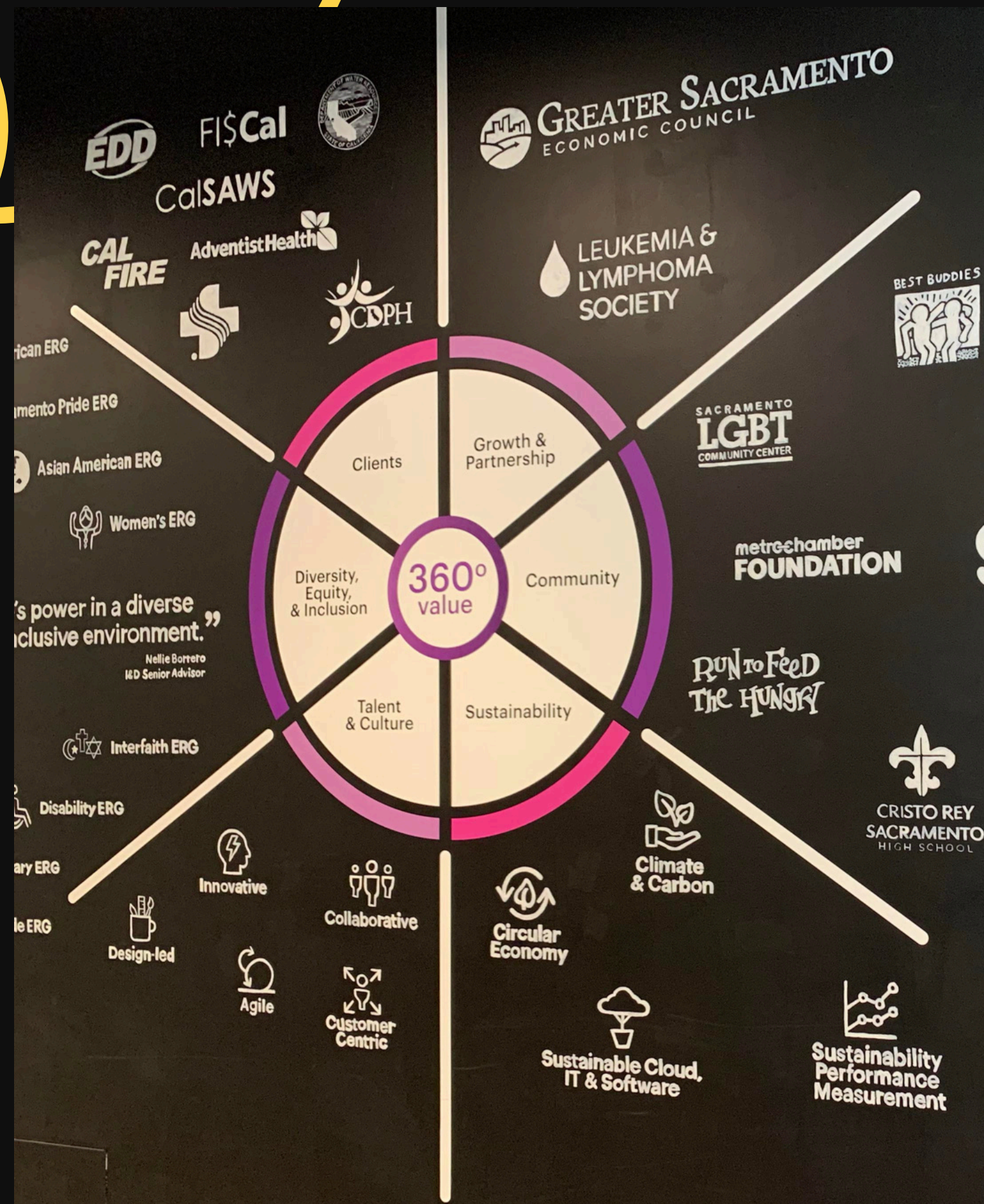
