This Saturday we are attending the CTA statewide *Fight For Schools* rally at Cesar Chavez Plaza and in the evening will attend Sac. City Councilmember Eric Guerra's fundraiser at Fairytale Town.

In July the LRCFT will help staff the California State Fair union booth.

In August during flex week, the LRCFT and FACCC will hold a faculty retirement and benefits conference at Sac City College.

Our Executive Board will also attend a CCC Division Council meeting in San Diego in August.
