Recently, we've worked collaboratively to support and rank two new full-time Classified positions, creating a classified workgroup with representation from across all three college service areas to develop a rubric that ties directly to our college's vision, values, and strategic plan — ensuring our process is transparent and aligned with our campus priorities. We look forward to welcoming these new positions and more to come as our student numbers continue to grow.

We're also in the process of updating our Senate bylaws to make them more inclusive and strengthen participation from our Classified Professionals, with allowances for classified senators to share positions, expansion of our cabinet to include Senator-at-Large positions, and increasingly inclusive language towards Classified Temporary employees.
