The LRCFT continues to negotiate with the district to renew our contract. We look forward to making further progress this summer.

The LRCFT PAFC met in May and June to endorse local and statewide candidates for the November general election. We endorsed Los Board board President Deborah Ortiz for trustee and look forward to campaigning for her.

The LRCFT is sending 16 delegates to the AFT biennial convention in Washington D.C. next week. In August we will join CFT in a union retreat in San Diego.

We will also participate in late July in staffing the union booth at the CA. state fair along with other unions in the Sacramento Central Labor Council.

In response to recent questions regarding the LRCFT's position on a potential bond measure sponsored by the District, the LRCFT is taking a neutral position until we meet as a board in September to make a recommendation to our membership. We all want more resources for our students.
