Student led-activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- ARC: Collaborating with Beaver Cares to provide hygiene kits in accordance with AB 1995. Distributed 2022-2023 student election packets
- CRC: Welcome Week/Spring Fest planning for late March or early April. Continued preparations for 2022-2023 student elections
- FLC: Equity Center hosting Women’s History Month celebration events by PEAC²E Peer Mentors
- SCC: Working on student election advertisements to increase student engagement. Planning to table on campus to encourage students to run for office. Working on the free section and club involvement for Student Resource Hub on Canvas.

Senate and CAEB Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC: Provided feedback for Guided Pathways Scale of Adoption and HomeBase.
- CRC: Attended Los Rios’s annual Lobby Day event on March 3rd
- FLC: Attended Lobby Day on March 3rd to advocate for legislation that address housing insecurity and homelessness among college students
- SCC: Continuing work on digital and physical time capsules. Presentation regarding anti-Proctorio student-led petition during Senate meeting on March 15th

- ARC: Work Experience Program presentation for March 11th. Upcoming Student Senate bill receive funding to attend student-led sustainability virtual workshop
