Below is a list of highlighted activities, accomplishments and events at each of the colleges within the Los Rios District. Late submissions/unauthorized reports will not be presented at the BOT meeting.

Student-led activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- ARC: Club Rush event was held on September 20th with eighteen clubs present.
- CRC: Student Body Association (SBA) tabled for Constitution Day on September 15th. Currently planning a voter registration event on October 20th, and an activity for Halloween on October 27th.
- FLC: Multiple CSU and UC informational webinars for transfer are being held.
- SCC: Planning De-Stress event for finals week in November and December.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC: Actively promoting resources about voter registration to the student body, in accordance with AB 963. SBA has appointed three students to council, and one student as a representative at SSCCC.
- CRC: Senate is appointing students PG Committees and promoting their association via fliers and tables.
- FLC: Senators receiving access to an ASFLC email and working with Student Services Administration to aid in increasing student engagement on campus.
- SCC: Two club days offered in hyflex mode, senators presented to a First Year Experience class about student leadership, and the Student Senate tabled at Black Student Welcome event.

Leadership Development Accomplishments (i.e. conferences, trainings, workshops, guest speakers):

- All campuses: Attending CCCSAA Conference in San Diego.
- ARC: CAEB officers completed their orientation and CAEB President Kevin Hill will formally present at this year's CCCSAA (California Community College Student Affairs Association) conference.
- CRC: On October 20th, Armando Salud, Deputy of Election for Yolo County, will speak at the Rock the Boat and Get Out and Vote event on October 20th.
