- ARC: ARC’s associated student body held a leadership and development event for their campus’s Week of Welcome (WOW) on January 18th and appropriated \$20,000 in general funds for CAEB activities.
- CRC: CAEB and Student Senate tabled at CRC’s Hawk Days event.
- FLC: Hosted a club rush event.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC: Three new clubs were chartered by CAEB.
- CRC: Student Senate President Jocelin Avila spoke at the Spring Convocation on January 13th.
