- ARC: Participated in district wide Lobby Day on Thursday, February 23rd.
- CRC: Student Senate participated in Lobby Day on Thursday, February 23rd and met with six legislative offices.
- FLC: Hosted "International Night" on March 2nd, from 4:00pm-6:00pm.
- SCC: Student Associated Council participated in Lobby Day on Thursday, February 23rd.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC: Sponsored a Black History Month event titled "Black History Month Block Party," collaborated with campus leaders on the construction of the ARC 2023-2030 strategic goals, and appointed students to the ARC Elections Committee.
