The Student Trustee in consultation with the SAC Advisor will compile these submissions for one comprehensive report which is due to District Advisor Dr. Sonia Ortiz Mercado, the designated student speaker, and SAC Advisor by noon the Friday before the BOT meeting. Late submissions/unauthorized reports will not be presented at the BOT meeting.

Student-led activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- ARC: Senate promoting upcoming ASB and Student Trustee elections. CAEB is planning a de-stress event for finals on May 4th, 2023.
- CRC: ASCRC has begun the election process and is reaching out to prospective students for the 2023-24 academic year.
- FLC: Hosted the following events: Spirit Week from April 3rd - 6th, Spring Dance on April 7th.
- SCC: Student leaders hosted a “meet & greet” for prospective students interested in student government.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC: ASB has been promoting a survey by faculty that is available on eServices and has appointed a new Region II delegate for the SSCCC.
- CRC: President Jocelin Avila represented CRC at the SSCCC’s annual General Assembly in Long Beach, CA.
- FLC: Appointed student to represent FLC at the SSCCC’s annual General Assembly in Long Beach, CA.
- SCC: Board is adjusting to Brown Act changes, and now actively meeting in-person despite attendance challenges for online students.

Leadership Development Accomplishments (i.e. conferences, trainings, workshops, guest speakers):

- ARC: The Dean of Research and Innovation presented on the current ARC Strategic Plan for 2023-2030 and CAEB is developing training for future representatives.
- CRC: Hired parliamentarians are finalizing constitution and bylaws updates, and the Senate President attended outreach and bureaucracy training at the General Assembly.
- FLC: Senate hosted a speaker from the SSCCC who presented on opportunities for student leaders on the statewide level.
- SCC: OWL technology now in full use for student leaders, and three students went to Long Beach, CA to participate in the SSCCC's annual General Assembly.
