Student-led activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- ARC is collaborating with Umoja and the Black Student Success Center to host the Mobile Black History Museum.
- CRC held a successful Hawk Day to promote student life
- SCC approved a resolution honoring student Taylor McClure for her contributions to the students of SCC to be presented to her family at her memorial.
- SCC is advocating for AB 1855 to allow remote participation in leadership meetings for community college students. They are preparing letters of support for Assemblymember Arambula.
- FLC held a club rush with over 100 students in attendance.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- ARC appointed students to Spring 24 faculty hiring committees.
- ARC's Club and Events Board has now reached over 40 student clubs on campus and will be hosting a Club Rush at the end of February.
- ARC led the state of California in student voter registration for California Community Colleges in 2023.
- CRC's student senate Board is almost filled through advertising during Hawk Days.
- SCC held a training from the SCC PRIE office to learn about SCC student demographics.
- FLC senate is now full for the first time post-COVID.
- FLC began drafting resolutions for the student senate of California's delegate assembly.

- SCC Approved to travel to the Washington DC student advocacy conference in March.
- SCC Preparing for the Student Senate of California Community Colleges annual legislative session in Santa Clara.
