Student Senates' Reports to the LRCCD Board of Trustees

April 2026

Student-Led Activities:

- American River College (ARC) approved \$10,000 in funding for Welcome to Finals Week, taking place May 5-7, to support student wellness and engagement. ARC will also serve as the future host site for the Region II Summit.
- Cosumnes River College (CRC) hosted its Spring Club Rush: "Find Your People" event and is planning Stress Relief Days to support students at the end of the semester.
- Folsom Lake College (FLC) hosted several student engagement events including a Speed-Friending event and Movie Night. Upcoming events include the STEM Fair on April 17 and the Artist Guild's annual Artist Alley on April 15-16.
- Sacramento City College (SCC) students participated in a Southern California university tour, visiting UC and CSU campuses to explore transfer opportunities.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments:

- ARC contributed student perspectives to the Los Rios AI Task Force and updated the Student Stipends Resolution to expand its language districtwide. The Senate also passed a resolution supporting student participation in faculty hiring committees and gathered campus-wide student feedback through posted outreach boards.
- CRC allocated funding for upcoming initiatives including the Oath of Office ceremony and advisor participation in the CCCSAA Conference. The Senate also reviewed the draft CRC ACCJC Midterm Report and continues producing student-led podcast content.
- FLC hosted a Pop-Up Café providing free food to students and is developing partnerships with local high schools to support dual enrollment and college pathways. The Senate also established a Constitution and Bylaws Committee to update governing documents.
- SCC approved an Empowerment Grant supporting the Watercolor Club and engaged in cross-campus dialogue with ARC on student stipends and governance updates. The Clubs and Events Board is collaborating with the President's Office to support Celebrate City and expand club participation.
- All four campuses are preparing for upcoming student elections through outreach, candidate engagement, and election planning.

Leadership Development Accomplishments:

- Student leaders from across the district attended the SSSCC General Assembly, voting on resolutions and representing their colleges in statewide governance.

- ARC hosted presentations on student participation in hiring committees and received updates from the President's Office on next year's Homecoming.
- CRC leadership continues engagement with campus administration, including meetings with President Dr. Bush.
- FLC student leaders are developing a student-led workshop series and received a presentation on the college's Accreditation Midterm Report from Dean of Equity and Institutional Effectiveness Lisceth Brazil-Cruz.
