Student Senates' Reports to the LRCCD Board of Trustees

May 2026

Student-Led Activities:

- All four colleges held candidate forums and supported student voter participation initiatives during the student election season.
- American River College (ARC) hosted a Candidate Mixer and will host the SCCC Region II Summit on June 2. ARC's Rugby Club also qualified for the CRAA Division 1 AA 7's National Championship, becoming the only community college in the country to qualify.
- Cosumnes River College (CRC) hosted a "Rock the Vote" event to encourage civic engagement and student voter participation. The Clubs and Events Board hosted Stress Relief Days to support student wellness during finals.
- Sacramento City College (SCC) hosted several campus engagement events, including the Asian Pacific Islander Heritage Festival, Celebrate City, Sexual Assault Awareness Month programming, and STEM-focused academic events through the Chemistry and Mathematics departments.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments:

- All four colleges completed student elections, selecting new board leadership for the upcoming academic year.
- ARC's Joint Budget Committee is developing funding allocation priorities for the upcoming academic year. Student leadership also met with students to address campus safety concerns for students taking evening classes and is planning an end-of-year retreat for the current board, incoming board, and administrators to support collaboration and a smooth leadership transition.
- SCC approved funding supporting student elections, leadership recognition programming, pre-finals wellness events, Celebrate City, Transfer Spring Fest, Earth Week, and student participation in the CCCSAA Conference. The Senate also supported the Writing Center AI Statement initiative, reviewed the ACCJC Midterm Report and discussed recommendations for future election processes and incoming student leadership. The Clubs and Events Board supported student election engagement and expanded club participation through Celebrate City programming.

Leadership Development Accomplishments:

- ARC hosted several presentations focused on institutional planning and student engagement. Region II Regional Affairs Director Kevin Hill presented plans for the upcoming Region II Summit. Vice President of Student Services Dr. David Miramontes Quiñonez presented the draft HomeBases Project Group Charter. Associate Vice President of Student Services Dr. Steven Roberson presented the Institutional Equity Plan for review and possible action. Two ARC students also presented a

proposal for website improvements, focusing on updating the calendar page for improved accessibility and layout. Amanda Lewis, the President's Assistant, presented the theme and plans for next year's Homecoming.

- CRC student leaders received a "State of the District" update from President Dr. Bush and participated in discussions with Andi Adkins Pogue regarding California's statewide Zero Textbook Cost initiative.
- SCC student leaders received a presentation from Dr. Andrew Coleman on campus safety initiatives and student support resources. Student leaders also met with Angie Lambert regarding the ACCJC Midterm Report process, with discussions focused on accreditation, institutional effectiveness, and the role of students in shared governance.
