Student-led activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- **SCC:** Hosted Get Out The Vote days on May 22–23, with cafe vouchers for student voters. Planned leadership recognition ceremony and Garden of Dreams networking/advocacy event.
- **FLC:** Held a movie day showing *Cars*. Preparing for the Student Awards Gala on May 24 to honor club and student government involvement.
- CRC: Multiple clubs engaged in off-campus activities: Outdoors Club visited Cronan Ranch, Psychology Scholars visited UC Davis, Photography Club toured Crocker Art Museum, and Inclusive Nutrition Club visited Better Meat Co.
- ARC: Planning an end-of-year retreat and transition meeting for current and incoming ASB members (June 3–4 at Folsom Courtyard Marriott).

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- **SCC:** Student Senate President and Secretary of Public Relations testified at a Higher Education Committee hearing in support of AB 409 (teleconferencing for student organizations). Also tabled at Celebrate City event.
- FLC: Completed 2025–26 elections. Identified Senate vacancies (Director of Legislative Affairs, Secretary, Senators) and CAEB vacancies (Vice Commissioner, Secretary, Finance Director, Historian, Delegates). Approved recommendation to adopt the 2025–26 College Strategic Plan. Participated in Chancellor search forum on May 7.
- **CRC:** Passed funding for Rock the Vote events. Senate and CAEB participated in the Chancellor Forum.
- ARC: Passed Resolution S25-01 advocating for student rights amid national uncertainty. Held elections with food and voter engagement at ARC and Natomas Center. Psi Beta club conducted a transportation survey and will present findings on May 15.

Leadership Development Accomplishments (i.e. conferences, trainings, workshops, guest speakers):

- **SCC**: Attended General Assembly. Hosted guest speakers President Albert Garcia and Director Camille Broussard Wise. Held a 5th Tuesday scavenger hunt-style training.
- FLC: Transferring ASFLC class participated in a college-wide recognition ceremony.
- CRC: Welcomed President Bush to the Senate meeting on April 25 for institutional updates.

ARC: Approved preliminary funding for CCCSAA 2025 conference (Santa Clara, October 17–19). Appointed students to 12 faculty hiring committees, VPSS panel, and had 9 students attend Chancellor feedback session with PPL Consulting on May 5.
