Student Senates' Reports to the LRCCD Board of Trustees

Student-Led Activities:

- Welcome Week events were held across the district, including Hawk Days at Cosumnes River College, Week of Welcome at American River College, and interactive welcome tables at Folsom Lake College.
- Sacramento City College is planning a combined event on September 17 to recognize Club Day, U.S. Constitution Day, Voter Registration Day, and Welcome Back activities.
- American River College hosted Arcade Day on August 28, fostering student engagement and community building.
- Folsom Lake College is organizing a recruitment event focused on connecting students with shared governance committees.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments:

- Students have been appointed to shared governance committees across the district, ensuring student representation in campus decision-making.
- Folsom Lake College established strategic priorities with assigned leads to guide Senate and Clubs & Events Board work.
- American River College's Student Senate formed an ad hoc committee focused on food accessibility.
- Sacramento City College began its Fall 2025 Senate session on August 26 and acquired a new mascot costume (Huey 3.0) to enhance school spirit.
- Club development continues to expand districtwide:
 - o American River College's Club and Events Board has chartered 23 clubs and is planning Club Day on September 16, in collaboration with El Centro's Bienvenida 2025.
 - o Folsom Lake College is preparing for Club Rush from September 8-11.

Leadership Development Accomplishments:

- All four colleges have held or planned retreats and orientations to onboard new student leaders. American River College hosted a two-day ASB Orientation in July, and Folsom Lake College held an August retreat covering governance structures and leadership skills.
- Sacramento City College conducted two summer training days and continues weekly leadership development sessions through its Super Tuesday program.
- Cosumnes River College's ASCRC Advisor will lead a Lobby Day workshop on September 5.
- Funding has been approved across multiple campuses to support attendance at the 2025 CCCSAA Student Leadership Conference in October.
