## Student Senates' Reports to the LRCCD Board of Trustees

### October 2025

### Student-Led Activities:

- Student-led events were held across the district to promote engagement and community building:
  - American River College hosted the Karaoke Midterm Mic Drop on October 23 and is preparing for the Campus Life Tea Party Workshop in November.
  - Cosumnes River College assisted with Voter Registration Day and is organizing Fall Club Rush at the end of October.
  - Folsom Lake College hosted Movie Night: K-Pop Demon Hunters and initiated new collaborations with the Innovation and Welcome Center.
  - Sacramento City College held Club Day, Constitution Day, and Voter Registration Day celebrations, along with Raza Bienvenida and HSI Tardeada events, engaging more than 230 participants.

### Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments:

- Students across all colleges were appointed to district and campus committees, including faculty hiring committees, supporting shared governance and student representation.
- Club development continues to grow districtwide:
  - American River College hosted its first Club Day with 45 active clubs and is planning an event for Homecoming on October 28.
  - Cosumnes River College chartered 19 clubs and finalized top advocacy topics for Lobby Day.
  - Folsom Lake College hosted Club Rush and established subcommittees for Lobby Day preparation, student grievances, and Town Halls.
- Leadership and advocacy initiatives include:
  - Folsom Lake College worked with campus administration on water filter replacement and passed a resolution supporting extended library hours.
  - Cosumnes River College's Student Senate President serves as the SSCCC Region II delegate, and Sacramento City College hosted a guest speaker from SSCCC Region II to provide an overview of student advocacy work.

### Leadership Development Accomplishments:

- Colleges held retreats, workshops, and training to onboard and develop student leaders.
- Students from all four colleges will attend the CCCSAA Student Leadership Conference on October 17-19 in Santa Clara, California.

- American River College hosted presentations on Homebase updates and library services.
- Cosumnes River College provided input on the Study Equity Plan during a presentation from the Dean of Institutional Effectiveness Research and Planning.
- Sacramento City College conducted Super Tuesday and Fifth Tuesday leadership training covering governance, planning, and student engagement practices.
