Student-led activities (i.e. March in March, campus events, fundraisers):

- ARC ASB hosted orientation from August 4–6.
- ARC approved funding to support voter registration efforts.
- CRC Fall Hawk Days will be held on August 31 - September 1.
- CRC Welcome Week was held from August 24 - 26.
- FLC Senate planned outreach tables to increase involvement on campus
- SCC Council is planning annual Club/Constitution/Voter Registration Day and Welcome Back for students.

Senate and Clubs & Events Board Accomplishments (i.e. surveys, engagement in campus and regional governance):

- SCC Campus currently has six active clubs and two prospective clubs.
- SCC Student Senate is discussing priorities for the upcoming year. Continuing the council's previous work regarding Artificial Intelligence, as well as a focus on Open Educational Resources (OERs) and Zero-Cost Textbooks (ZTCs) are in discussion. Planning to create educational pamphlets/brochures regarding California's upcoming November Governor's election, as well as the district's bond measure to be part of our annual Club/Constitution/Voter Registration Day.
- SCC Student Senate has all positions filled within its main board and ten senators! Ten remaining vacancies for Senators.
- SCC Club & Events Board created an ad-hoc consisting of students to support our upcoming Club/Constitution/Voter Registration Day. Another ad-hoc was created to coordinate our college's 100th Anniversary event taking place on October 22nd. A last ad-hoc was created to establish a celebration for the new mascot, Hughie 3.0.
- SCC Club & Events Board currently has four filled positions and two vacancies within its main board, and ten Project Coordinator vacancies.

- FLC Senate held its strategic planning day and finished the Strategic priorities for the year.
- FLC Senate set goals including increasing community involvement and awareness of ASFLC
- FLC Senate appointed members and now a full senate
- FLC CAEB held appointments and increased its membership to 11 members
- FLC All executive positions on CAEB have been filled
- CRC identified two student representatives (Keira Moeckly and Kim My Do) to serve on the New Faculty Orientation student panel on August 19, 2026.
- CRC Appointed Student Representatives to shared governance committees, including the Cultural Competence and Equity, Participatory Governance Council, Disciplinary Appeals, Professional Development, and Resources committees.
- CRC Approved a stipend allocation per CRC Student for Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 for participating in participatory governance committees.
- CRC Passed funding to reimburse CRC student leaders and advisors for travel to SAC and Board of Trustees (BoT) meetings for the 2026 - 2027 academic year.
- ARC ASB tabled during Fall Kickoff on August 13–14.
- ARC ASB hosted a Meet and Greet table on August 26 to engage with students.
- ARC Held first meeting. The Student Senate discussed plans for classroom visits.
- ARC The Student Senate passed a resolution regarding student government stipends.
- ARC The Student Senate passed a resolution supporting student participation in hiring committees.

Leadership Development Accomplishments (i.e. conferences, trainings, workshops, guest speakers):

- ALL Approved funds for CCCSAA
- ALL Student Senate Presidents spoke at convocation
- FLC Both Senate and CAEB held a 2 day retreat to introduce new members to student government and how ASFLC functions
- FLC Had an introduction between Academic Senate and Student Senate to discuss continued partnership
- SCC Council participated in two Summer trainings/planning sessions ahead of the 2026-2027 school year. Goals and ideas were discussed regarding both Student Senate and Club and Events Board. Guest speakers, including SCC college President Albert Garcia, and Creative Director Tess Smith.
- SCC Council completed our first “Super Tuesday” weekly training this past August 25th.
- CRC ASCRC Training was held from August 4 - 6. SSSCC attended the training.
- ARC Representatives from SSSCC and Affordable Access attended ASB Orientation on Aug 4-6 as guest speakers.
