Project review: Briefly discussed the project including but not limited to the following items:

- 1. Submittals, bid deadline, required bid documents, Board approval date, addendum postings, attached agenda items.
- 2. Attendees advised to refer to project manual for details.
- 3. It is not mandatory that the plans are purchased from ARC Document Solutions; however, ARC is the official reprographics, and all addenda are issued from ARC.
- 4. Procedures for handling questions and requests for information, and deadline to submit RFI's.
- 5. Request for information will be accepted until **12:00 PM**, **Friday**, **June 15, 2018**.

Items discussed:

- 1. Reviewed project's scope.
- 2. Viewed existing building interior, exterior, roof, and basement.
- 3. Viewed LRC plant and yard attached to LRC.
- 4. Is the project LEED equivalent? Yes, LEED silver equivalent.
- 5. Location of contractor access? Staging area identified in Lot F and will be coordinated with Project Manager Charlie Uhlmeyer, Campus and awarded contractor. Subcontractor parking to be contained within contractor's area. Refer to specs and plans.
- 6. Path of travel for equipment? South end of site.
- 7. Will there be a full time DSA inspector on the job? Yes.
- 8. The site is located on a fully, operational campus.
- 9. Adjacent building, Lillard Hall is occupied early morning until late evening.
- 10. Smoking is not allowed on campus property.
- 11. Area power and water available? Yes through abatement.
- 12. Once trees identified in the scope of work are cut, is drying the wood to be made into furniture also including in the scope? Three trees identified on drawing / photo will be cut prior to contract start. Contractor is responsible for removal of stump and root ball and all remaining trees identified for removal on plans.
- 13. An old project backfilled a southwest classroom in existing building. Drawings do not identify the backfill material, however existing building structural drawings will be provided for reference.

- 14. Viewed sloped seated classroom to be demolished and brought up to grade.
- 15. Is import of soil and compaction part of demolition scope? Yes.
- 16. Any tensioning on existing structure? No. It was "built stout".
- 17. Can arrangements be made to see the site with subcontractors? Yes. Contact Los Rios CCD Project Manager Charlie Uhlmeyer at (916) 856-3420.
- 18. Is there only one basement? Yes.
- 19. Is there access to the underground transite pipe? No
- 20. Existing building is full wythe brick, new building will be thin brick veneer.
- 21. Where does the existing building need to be filled? Basement and sloped seating classrooms
