## 1.0 International Students

- 1.1 Requirements for Admissions
  - General requirements for admission are: 1.1.1
    - 1.1.1.1 The equivalent of a U.S. high school diploma (12 years of education) with a G.P.A. of 2.0 or above, or equivalent;
    - 1.1.1.2 a score as determined and published by the college on the test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and/or a college specific English as a second language assessment;
    - 1.1.1.3 a financial resource certification;
    - 1.1.1.4 a tuberculin clearance examination prior to registration. Tuberculosis tests will be given at campus health centers;
    - 1.1.1.5 proof of acceptable health insurance coverage for the period of time the student will be in the United States:
    - 1.1.1.6 a fifty dollar (\$50.00) International Student Application fee payable at the time of application for admission; and
    - 1.1.1.7 approval by the BCIS (Bureau of Citizenship & Immigration Services) that the office of the Secretary of State has approved a Visa admitting the Alien to enter the United States and enroll at an approved institution of higher learning.
  - 1.1.2 High School International Students
    - 1.1.2.1 High school international students (F-1, J-1 or other non immigrant status) are admissible on an individual basis to be determined by the college specific Designated School Official(s) or by the College President.
  - 1.1.3 Concurrent Enrollment Students
    - 1.1.3.1 International students wishing to concurrently enroll at another Los Rios Community College are admissible on an individual basis to be determined by the college specific's 1-20 Designated School Official(s) or by the College President.
  - 1.1.4 For college transfers, the additional qualifications are:
    - 1.1.4.1 For new students transferring within the United States, students must be in status to be eligible for transfer. Students must submit a "transfer form/letter" completed at the previous school by the

designated school official within fifteen (15) days of the student's attendance at the new college.

1.2 International student fees are assessed at the non-resident rate plus an additional fee for capital outlay.
